### Terms of Payment

100% upon receipt of agreement and invoice.

All payments must be received before the start of ECCB 2026. Should the Sponsor/Exhibitor fail to complete payments prior the commencement of the Congress, the Organiser will be entitled to cancel the reservation while cancellation will be subject to cancellation fees as determined below.

Sponsoring and exhibiting arrangements will be confirmed in writing between the ECCB 2026 Secretariat and the sponsoring/exhibiting organisation using the standard ECCB 2026 booking form. An invoice with payment details will be sent together with the booking form.

After receipt of the sponsorship booking form you will receive an invoice, payable within 30 days after receipt. If the invoice has not been fully paid prior to the Congress, you will not have access to the Congress.

#### Cancellation / Modification Policy

Cancellation or modification of items must be made via e-mail to the ECCB 2026 Congress Secretariat: [eccb2026@congressbydesign.com](mailto:eccb2026@congressbydesign.com).

The Organisers shall retain:

- 10% of the agreed package amount if the cancellation/modification is made 6 months before the start of the Congress
- 50% of the agreed package amount if the cancellation/modification is made 6-3 months before the start of the Congress
- 100% of the agreed package amount if the cancellation/modification is made less than 3 months before the start of the Congress

Any refunds of deposits paid will be made after the Congress but no later than 31 August 2026. The company will not be entitled to any interest that the Organiser may have derived from deposits made by the company. All bank charges, including senders and receiver's charges, resulting from a refund related to cancellation of a sponsorship/exhibition items will be passed on to the sponsor/exhibitor.
